When citing electronic sources consulted online, the Chicago style citation manual recommends including an electronic resource identifier, where possible, to lead your reader directly to the source. A URL is a uniform resource locator, which directs the reader straight to the online source.

Citing Images (Chicago) - Chicago Style Citation Guide ...

The Chicago Manual of Style has 2 distinct citation formats: Author-Date, which uses in-text citations, and Notes-Bibliography (NB), which uses footnotes or endnotes. Author-Date citations are more commonly used in the sciences and social sciences, while the NB style is more standard for works in the arts, history, and humanities. [1]

Citing Your Sources. Chicago style has two citation styles to let readers know that you used information from somewhere else and to show them where to find it. notes and bibliography style; author-date style. Though different, each style allows you to tell your readers how you found your information.

The notes and bibliography style is one of two citation options provided by the Chicago Manual of Style. Each time a source is quoted or paraphrased, a superscript number is placed in the text, which corresponds to a footnote or endnote containing details of the source.

Chicago Style Footnotes | Citation Format and Examples

Chicago Citation Format (Chicago Manual of Style, 15th ed., sections 17.270, 17.237) Structure: Author last name, first name, middle initial, if given. If no author, use the site owner. Title of Site (italicized); a subsection of a larger work is in quotes. Editor of site, if given. Publication information, including latest update if available.

A Chicago Citation Generator is a software tool that automatically generates citations and bibliographies in the Chicago citation style. Citations can be created by entering an identifying piece of information about a source, such as a website URL, book ISBN, or journal article DOI to the generator.
